As of January 14, 2018, Yuba Sutter Healthcare Council (YSHC) has worked to tackle the growing problem of opioid overdoses and misuse in Yuba and Sutter Counties. YSHC has addressed this matter by gathering multiple stakeholders to assess and create solutions, focusing on the three federal priority areas of safe prescribing practices, medication-assisted treatments and increasing access to naloxone.

Collaboration/Engagement/Education Committee

Goal

- To offer an educational presentation as an annual service to targeted populations and have agreement with new service provider to participate in coalition and support.
- Have YSHC represented at a minimum of 3 community events throughout 2019

Future Goals:

- Coordinate educational presentations as an annual service to targeted populations and develop agreements with new service providers to participate in the YSHC Coalition
- Ensure compliance with local, state and federal regulations pertaining to opioid education, prevention and policies
- Organize and host our own community event
- Have YSHC represented at a minimum of 5 community events in 2020

Objectives:

- Create & provide educational material regarding opioids and other health issues
- Seek out community events for YSHC to attend
- Collaborate with other committees & organizations to determine what topics are of interest
- Act as ambassadors for YSHC in the community
- Keep Facebook page updated regarding events and educational opportunities
- Recruit and develop new members to help implement YSHC programs and services
- Ensure website, sponsorship package and marketing materials are developed, updated, and available to receive sponsors, donations and memberships

Bylaws/Governance Committee

Goal:

- Ensure that YSHC, as a healthcare council, are operating according to our established bylaws.
- YSHC have our own nonprofit 501 c 3
- YSHC be compliant and up to date with regulations pertaining to opioid education, prevention and policy

Objectives:

- Maintain the bylaws
- Ensure that the bylaws are updated as needed
- Bring it to the attention of the board if we feel there is a need for an update to the bylaws
- Review, recommend and update bylaws as needed
- Review organizational nonprofit structure and make recommendations
- Ensure meetings and organization are operated according to bylaws

- Review grant opportunities and make recommendations
- Evaluate and coordinate staff response to ensure successful grant implementation

Recruitment/Marketing Committee

Goal

- To secure one new member or market that is introduced and implements YSHC programs and services
- Ensure website, and marketing materials are developed and available to receive sponsors, donations and memberships.

Ensure all services and relevant information related to opioid use are inventoried, available, and provided to Sutter and Yuba County Residents
